


# PROSTATE CANCER

### PROCEDURE

- Step 1: Questionnaire detailing medical history.
- Step 2: Ultrasound scan of bladder, kidneys & prostate.
- Step 3: Urine flow measurement.
- Step 4: Urine Analysis
- Step 5: Blood Test

The whole procedure takes one hour, results are given immediately. This early detection system can help men to beat Prostate Cancer and maintain a normal life.
